Project Case Studies

Strategic Planning to Help PCORI’s Research Priorities Thrive

Relevant Capabilities: All Capability Areas

The Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI) engaged Ripple Effect to support development and implementation of a 10-year strategic plan, including engagement with PCORI’s operational and research divisions, senior staff, Strategic Planning Committee, and Board of Governors. We helped create PCORI’s National Priorities for Health and Research Agenda; co-led a workgroup on research methodology; managed and analyzed data for two Congressionally mandated public comment periods; and provided ongoing consultation on strategic planning best practices. We integrated PCORI’s DEI principles into the Strategic Plan, including web-based versions in both English and Spanish. We created tailored fact sheets for patients, healthcare professionals, and researchers, and developed videos, presentations, and briefing materials for PCORI’s engagement efforts. The Strategic Plan provides a flexible approach for achieving PCORI’s vision and mission and allows room for evolving needs and priorities so that PCORI’s research portfolio remains relevant.

Analysis of Public Comments and Stakeholder Feedback for CMS

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) actively solicits feedback from experts and stakeholder communities through many forums, including Requests for Information (RFIs); listening sessions; Notices of Proposed Rulemaking; and onsite engagements. Expert Guidance for AHRQ’s National Action Alliance to Advance Patient and Workforce Safety

Organizational Assessment of the Administration of NIGMS Research Capacity Building Programs

KHI APOL1 Nephropathy Roadmap to Increase Disease Awareness & Clinical Study Participation

Relevant Capabilities: Policy Support

Ripple Effect supported the Kidney Health Initiative (KHI) in developing a roadmap to increase awareness, access to testing, and clinical study participation for APOL1-kidney disease, which primarily affects people of African ancestry. This work included 1) managing four multidisciplinary expert workgroups, 2) planning, conducting, and analyzing 10 interviews with advisors in the kidney health community, 3) planning and facilitating an interactive workshop about the roadmap with KHI members, and 4) developing a communications and engagement plan for the roadmap. The information that we gathered and analyzed culminated in the development and design of an actionable roadmap that included resources for several audiences to achieve the goals of the roadmap.

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
