## Project Case Studies

### Program Administration and Technical Support Services

Our primary client was the Congressionally Directed Medical Research Programs (CDMRP), where we led program evaluation, analysis, communications, and management efforts across all 35 research programs, spanning the full breadth of DoD biomedical and health research.

### Program Evaluation and Award Management Support to CDMRP
